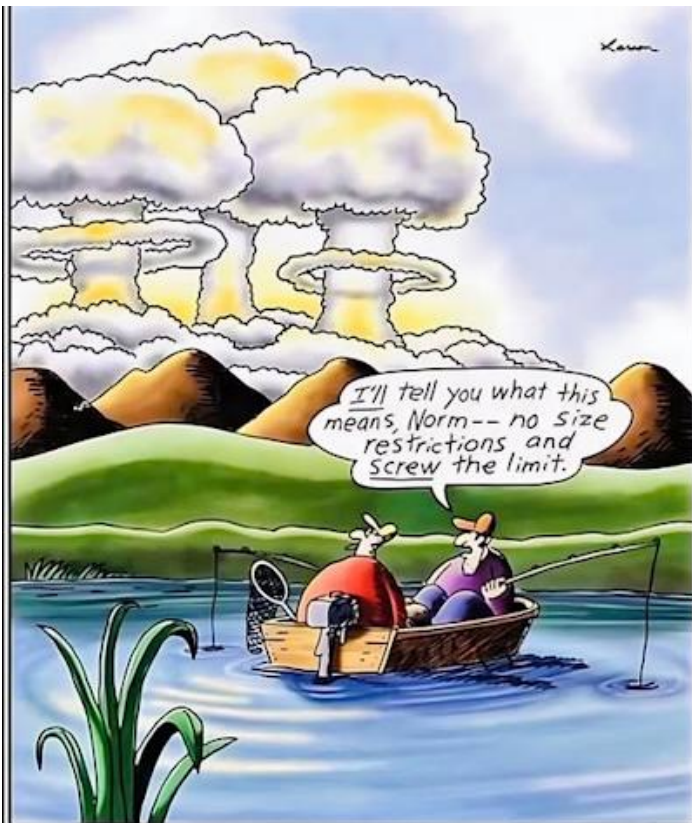

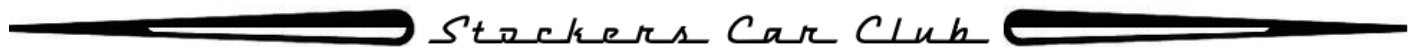
Don Wonders, El Presidente

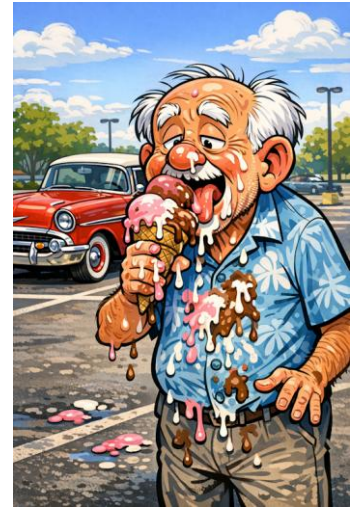
